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## Disorder

Disorder can be described as the absence of structure and differentiation. Its religious and scientific connotations have been quite negative in many cultures, identifying God as the source of creational order. In thermodynamics the entropy of a closed system is a measure of its disorder, which can only increase in due course of time.
