2.17. Area W

2.17.1. Stratigraphy and Architecture

WOLFGANG ZWICKEL

Area W is located in the westernmost part of Field II and it covers squares BL 2, BL 3, BM 2, BM 3, and BN 2. The area was excavated in 2004 by area supervisors JUHANA SAUKKONEN and VIRPI HOLMQVIST. Most of the loci belong to the Iron Age I period and will be published in a second volume of the excavation report. The post- and pre-Iron Age I material in this square is very limited. The loci found in this area can be attributed to the following strata:¹

The topsoil loci L. 5400 (BL 2), L. 5401 (BN 2), L. 5402 (BL 3), L. 5403 (BM 3), L. 5436 (BM 2), L. 5452 (BL/BM 2) yielded typical mixed pottery from different periods but no further architectural remains from periods younger than Iron Age I were found. Remarkably, among the finds is a fragment of a bulla (reg. no. 12012/1, L. 5400; Fig. 2.17.1.1) which contains two impressions. The left one presents ca. 2/5 of a rosette decoration (size of the preserved area: 18 x 6 mm), in the right one a bird, possibly an ostrich, with uplifted wings walking to the right. The designs are typical for the Late Bronze and Early Iron Age I period and this specific item may be connected with the Iron Age I settlement activity in this square or area.²

Nearly all excavated features of area W belong to the Iron Age I period. Only W5467 in square BN 2 is older. Since only its upper part was excavated very little is known about this wall. Because the focus was on the Iron Age I architecture, the excavations did not pursue to establish a floor for this wall. The wall is about 3 m long and at least 0.5 m wide partly covered by the nearly parallel Iron Age I wall W5440. Renewed excavations are necessary to understand the wall's context and dating.




Fig. 2.17.1.2. Wall W5467 below the Iron Age I wall W5440.
